## Abduction of Sida or Sida and the Golden Deer

Thotsakan, King of Giants (Nyak)
Malit, Thotsakan's younger brother and Nyak
Phralam
Phralak
Sida
Golden Deer (Malit in disguise)
Hermit (Thotsakan in disguise)
Sadayu



## Synopsis

Thotsakan expresses his desire to possess Sida to Malik and together they plot to abduct Sida from the forest where she resides with Phralak and Phralam.

On seeing Phralak, Phralam and Sida, Malit changes into a beautiful Golden Deer and prances playfully in front of them. Sida is very attracted to the Golden Deer and entreats Phralam to eatch it for her.

Phralam attempts several times to catch the Golden Deer and is led deep into the forest away from Sida and Phralak. His arrow injures the deer and thinking that it will die soon, he follows the injured deer further and further into the forest.

Nang Uma, his wife and a renowned beauty
Chithtabouth, Phakyin's General
Thotsakan
A harem of 6 Nang Kheos

Synopsis

Virahu makes a pilgrimage to pay his respects to Phakyin who lives on top of Mount Meru. He is overwhelmed by the beauty Mount Meru and starts to offer his praises, respects and prayers to the four directions. Kapkur (a lizard) misunderstands that the praises and respects and prayers are offered to him. He feels very proud and interrupts just before Virahu can finish his last prayer in the fourth direction.

Virahu is very upset by the arrogance and obvious disrespect of the Kapkur and threatens to kill him. He does'this by hurling his magical necklace at the Kapkur but inadvertently Mount Meru is also destroyed.
